Life is full of miracles, and this day holds every promise.


What does Christmas offer tomorrow,

looks like light, feels like warmth, smells like flowers, sounds like whispers.


Love, promised by God to the entire world

Thy kingdom come, thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven.


Give us this day our daily bread.


And forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive those who trespass against us.

O come to the cradle in Bethlehem's stall.


The shepherds are kneeling before his poor bed, while caroling angels are heard overhead.


